LiREM - Research laboratory in Management Studies

The laboratory brings together professors and researchers specialised in human resource management, marketing, finance, accounting, control, auditing, strategy, logistics or entrepreneurship.

Their research focuses on private organisations, associations, local authorities and health sector organisations. LiREM develops studies centered on the issue of management adapted to sustainable organizations.

CDRE - European Documentation and Research Center

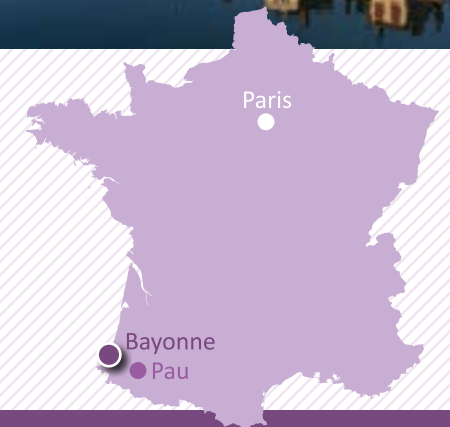
The CDRE develops in-depth scientific research in the European and cross-border field focusing on four main areas of research: Freedom, Security and Justice - European Integration - Law and Security - Borders, Territories and Cooperation.

These areas of research make it possible to address major societal issues, such as migration, European criminal law, the fight against terrorism and crime, mutual law enforcement assistance, European personal law, digital technology, regulations, food safety, transnational and European administrative law, or even cross-border and territorial cooperation.

IKER - Research Centre for Basque Language

IKER is the only laboratory in France specialised in Basque Studies. It brings together researchers from the CNRS as well as from UPPA and from the University of Bordeaux.

The centre's aim is to structure and raise awareness of Basque Studies in France.
